

Colleges Crossing Bridge, Mount Crosby Road – scour and batter protection works

Dear Stakeholder,

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) would like to advise that scour and batter slope protection works will be undertaken on the Colleges Crossing Bridge on Mount Crosby Road from early March 2024 to late June 2024.

These works are being undertaken to protect the bridge structure against further scouring, stabilise the batter slope, ensure network safety and preserve assets.

Work activities



- Installation of rockfill bags using 150mm diameter rocks around the bridge piers
- Earthworks on adjacent batter slope, including an extension of the existing concrete drain.

Timing



- Works will commence **early March 2024** and be completed in **late June 2024**, construction and weather conditions permitting.
- Typical construction hours will be from **6.30am to 5pm, Monday to Friday**.
- While majority of the works will be undertaken during the day, some Saturday or other out of hours works may be required.

Expected impacts



- Nearby residents and businesses can expect to experience short term impacts including increased noise and dust during the works.
- Traffic changes will include temporary lane closures and speed reductions, and short-term traffic disruption.
- Temporary diversions to the bikeway will be in place.
- Please allow extra time when planning your travel and follow the directions of roadside signage and traffic controllers.
- Minor vegetation removal within the treatment areas for access track and restoration works.
